Notes for contributors

- 1. *Social Work & Social Sciences Review* is published three times a year. It contains original articles, commissioned review articles and book reviews
- 2. Major articles and reviews should be between 4,000 and 6,000 words in length. Longer papers will be considered where the quality and theme of the paper justify its size and where the key messages are considered to be relevant and important by the Editors.
- 3. Shorter discussion papers should be between 2500 and 3500 words in length. Word limits do not include references.
- 4. Articles should be sent to the Editors as an email attachment in Word.
- 5. Articles submitted will be assessed by two assessors, and decisions as to publication made by the Editors in consultation, where necessary, with the Editorial Board. The Editors' decision is final.

Presentation

Name(s) of the author(s) should not appear in article metadata, or running headers or footers. A cover sheet should be sent which should include: the title; the name and professional designations of the author(s); and their address(es) including email address(es). Where their is more than one author, it should be indicated whose details should be included as the 'address for correspondence'. The cover sheet should also include a summary of no more than 200 words and six or so keywords.
